#### **Report of the Business Administrator**

### B1. Adoption of the 2025-2026 Final Budget:

Whereas, the Ocean Township Board of Education adopted a tentative budget 4/10/2025, and submitted it to the Executive County Superintendent of Schools for approval, and

Whereas, the tentative budget was approved by the Executive County Superintendent of Schools on April 11, 2025 and

Whereas, the tentative budget was advertised in the legal section of the Asbury Park Press on April 18, 2025, and

**Whereas**, in the proposed FY2026 State Budget, certain districts had the opportunity to apply to the Commission of Education to increase expenditures, including an allocation of Tax Levy Incentive Aid, in order to satisfy the thoroughness and efficiency standards established pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:7F-46, and

**Whereas**, Ocean Township Board of Education is below local fair share and spending below adequacy to be eligible to participate in this program, and

**Whereas**, Ocean Township Board of Education is eligible to increase expenditures by up to \$4,408,120 and qualify for Tax Levy Incentive Aid in the amount of up to \$220,406, and

**Whereas**, Ocean Township Board of Education has requested to increase expenditures by \$487,607 and qualify for Tax Levy Incentive Aid in the amount of \$23,219 and

Whereas, the Ocean Township Board of Education has requested and is **pending state approval** to increase expenditures based on the following reasons: For the restoration of three teaching positions, additional tuition adjustment payment that is due and to support out-of-district placement costs.

**Whereas**, the Ocean Township Board of Education has now determined to make modifications to the Tentative Budget as follows:

#### **Appropriation of Fund Balance:**

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education includes in the final budget an appropriation of fund balance in the amount of \$1,781,506.

#### Adjustment for Health Care Costs:

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education includes in the final budget the adjustment for increased costs of health benefits in the amount of \$190,886.

### Maintenance Reserve Withdrawal:

BE IT RESOLVED that as per N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-14.2(d) the general fund appropriations include a \$200,000 withdrawal from the Maintenance Reserve Account for use on required maintenance activities for a school facility as reported in the comprehensive maintenance plan (CMP) pursuant to N.J.A.C. 6A:26-20.5.

### Capital Reserve Withdrawal:

BE IT RESOLVED, that the 2025-2026 school district budget includes a withdrawal from capital reserve in the amount of \$600,000 for roof repairs at the Waretown Elementary School.

#### Enrollment Adjustment:

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education includes in the budget an adjustment for enrollment in the amount of \$16,866. The district intends to utilize this adjustment for salaries, supplies, and materials necessary for the additional students.

#### Maximum Travel:

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-7.3, a board of education must establish a maximum dollar limit for travel expenditure, as defined in N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-7.1 et seq.,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education includes in the final budget a maximum travel expenditure in the amount of \$25,000 for 2025-2026 school year. The maximum travel expenditure amount for 2024-2025 school year is \$25,000, of which \$181.16 has been spent and \$-0- is encumbered as of April 28, 2025.

WHEREAS, The Board of Education recognizes school staff and Board members will incur travel expenses related to and within the scope of their current responsibilities and for travel that promotes the delivery of instruction or furthers the efficient operation of the school district;

AND, N.J.A.C. 6A:23A Subchapter 7 requires Board members to receive approval of these expenses by a majority of the full voting membership of the Board and staff members to receive prior approval of these expenses by the Superintendent of Schools and a majority of the full voting membership of the Board;

AND, a board of education may establish, for regular district business travel only, an annual school year threshold of \$1,000 per staff member or district board of education member where prior Board approval shall not be required unless this annual threshold for a staff member is exceeded in a given school year (July 1 through June 30); AND, travel and related expenses not in compliance with N.J.A.C. 6A:23A Subchapter 7 but deemed by the board of education to be necessary and unavoidable as noted on the approved Board of Education Out-of-District Travel and Reimbursement Forms;

NOW BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Education approves all travel not in compliance with N.J.A.C. 6A:23A Subchapter 7 as being necessary and unavoidable as noted on the approved Board of Education Out-of-District Travel and Reimbursement Forms;

and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Board of Education includes in the final budget travel and related expense reimbursements in accordance with N.J.A.C. 6A:23A Subchapter 7, to a maximum expenditure of \$25,000 for all staff and board members for 2025-2026 school year.

The School Business Administrator/Board Secretary shall track and record these costs to ensure that the maximum amount is not exceeded.
