
NOVEMBER 8th REFERENDUM

SAVE OUR SCHOOLS



Ballot Question:

The Ocean Township Board of Education seeks to increase the tax levy by \$840,000 for the purpose of maintaining employment of 8 classroom teachers currently funded by expiring Federal COVID Grant funds. Since the implementation of the 2018 revised state school funding formula, the Ocean Township School District realized a cumulative loss of state funding of \$4.7 million to date. Approval of this question will allow for maintenance of current class size guidelines of less than 28 students per class in Kindergarten through 6th grade. These expenditures are in addition to those required to achieve New Jersey Student Learning Standards. Approval will result in a permanent increase in the district's tax levy.




Tax Impact Based on Assessed Value*


